## OUR PLAN



We will begin our service at 10:00. Please arrive early if you can. There will be lots of distractions and challenges. Your timely arrival will help us to minimize that.



We will conduct our service in the parking lot in front of Frazier Hall. We will have areas for seating marked out for social distancing. Please bring your own chairs if possible. Our greeters will be assisting folks in finding areas that they can sit. We will have some chairs available for those who need them.



We will also provide a small area for cars intended for seniors and those with challenged immune systems.



Greeters will spray your hands with sanitizer as you enter the worship area, and you will be able to sanitize your hands throughout the service.



The building will be closed except for the three restrooms near Frazier Hall. They will be sanitized before the service.



We are planning to create a bulletin that is in a PDF format. This will be sent via the WFC Email list and possibly on the Facebook page.



Masks are encouraged but not required outside.




There will be no children's ministries at this time during the service.

The sanctuary has been sectioned off so that people will be seated with proper social distancing.

We will try to dismiss and seat people so we do not have social distancing crowd issues.

The sanctuary bathrooms will be cleaned and available for the service.

Masks will be requested but not mandated. We will have a specific area in the sanctuary for those unable to wear masks.

We are working hard to develop a service that is God-honoring, safe and will allow for as many people as possible to participate under these conditions. It's been a long time, and now more than ever, I understand Paul's words in Philippians 4:1. Be praying for leadership and the church body as we begin to meet again on campus.
